No matter what our racial status may be, the ground is level in Christ! “There is neither Jew nor Greek.” Like the racially centered barriers in our day, much division was fostered around these two classifications. But because of “The Big Level” in Christ, not only could Jews and Greeks both find acceptance with God, they could experience acceptance with one another. Thankfully, this wonderful acceptance is available to us today.

No matter what our social status may be, the ground is level in Christ! “There is neither bond nor free.” Another great gap existed between slaves and slave-owners, employees and employers, or the Nobody’s working for the Somebody’s. “The Big Level” in Christ, however, destroyed this great expanse. In Christ there are no lowly Nobody’s or exalted Somebody’s. No matter where we are on the social ladder, we “are all one in Christ Jesus.”

No matter what our personal status may be, the ground is level in Christ! “There is neither male nor female.” We sometimes forget that there was a day in human history when women were given no praise, esteem, or appreciation. But due to “The Big Level” in Christ believing women can enjoy a common acceptance with believing men. In spiritual oneness and unity, the two can worship, pray, and praise God together.
